Compliance

PLEASE NOTE: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to comply with the local authority's regulations, EFPIA (European Federation of Pharmaceutical Industries and Associations [www.efpia.eu]) and IFPMA (International Federation of Pharmaceutical Manufacturers & Associations [www.ifpma.org]) Codes of Practice on the Promotion of Medicines.

Food and Beverage Distribution

- No alcoholic beverages may be served or distributed in the exhibit hall
- All items are limited to sample-size quantities using disposable containers and must be purchased through the hotel

Space Assignment and Fees

Space will be assigned upon receipt of a signed contract and deposit, and dependent on the availability of requested space, special needs, and compatibility of exhibitors' products. If it becomes necessary to reassign the space, the IAPRD will make every effort to relocate the exhibitor to a similar space. **Requests for space will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.**

The subletting, reassignment, or apportionment of any part of any exhibitor's space is prohibited.

Nonprofit Exhibit Space

The IAPRD offers relevant nonprofit associations complimentary tabletops in the exhibit hall. The requests are on a first-come basis and must be accompanied by proof of nonprofit status. Complimentary tabletop exhibitors will be required to pay a full registration fee. Tabletops include a table skirt, two chairs, and garbage pail. Tabletops will be assigned by the IAPRD based on availability in the exhibit hall.

Setup

All exhibits must be set up starting Wednesday, 11 November, between the hours of **09:00** and **16:30**. The aisles must be cleared by **16:45** on Wednesday, 11 November, without exception.

Dismantling

All exhibit materials must be packed and ready for removal from the exhibit hall on Saturday, 14 November. Tear down begins at **12:30 pm**.

Giveaways, Prizes, and Drawings

All giveaways, prizes, sponsored contests, and drawings are permitted if permission is received in advance from the IAPRD. They may not exceed the AMA, PhRMA and other Guidelines regarding gifts to physicians.

Security

Security services will be provided pre-/post- and during the congress. The IAPRD, the NH Milano Congress Centre, and the official security company are not responsible for any loss or damage to exhibitor property.

Certificate of Insurance

The IAPRD does not provide liability or property damage insurance for exhibitors' property. Exhibitors will be responsible for adequately ensuring their indemnification liability and property damage risks and will be required to submit a certificate of insurance to the IAPRD. Externally-appointed contractors will also be required to submit a certificate of insurance to the IAPRD.



Exhibition (*cont'd*)

Activities Not Allowed

The IAPRD has the right to request the exhibitor immediately discontinue an activity or cease distribution of materials deemed inappropriate by the IAPRD.

The following promotional practices are prohibited (this list is not exhaustive):

- Distribution of lanyards
- Unofficial door drops at congress hotel
- Press conferences or filming in exhibit area
- Photography of any kind unless requested in writing
- Illegal raffles and drawings
- Operating x-ray equipment
- Use of microphones
- Materials featuring paid job advertisements
- Use of magicians, fortune tellers, dancers, mimes, puppet shows, balloons (helium or otherwise), or other entertainment
- Entering the nonpublic area of another exhibitor's booth without permission
- Excessive noise levels for prerecorded music or presentations
- Live music

Indemnification

The exhibitor agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the IAPRD and the NH Milano Congress Centre, along with their respective members, officers, directors, agents, and employees from and against any and all liabilities, damages, actions, costs, losses, claims, and expenses (including attorneys' fees) on account of personal injury, death, or damage to or loss of property or profits arising out of or resulting, in whole or in part, from any act, omission, negligence, fault, or violation of law or ordinance of the exhibitor or its employees, agents, subcontractors or invitees when installing, removing, maintaining, occupying or using the exhibition premises within the NH Milano Congress Centre.

Cancellation Policy

If written cancellation is received by the IAPRD on or before Friday, 7 August 2026, a full refund will be granted, less €500 to be withheld as a cancellation fee. If the exhibiting company cancels after Monday, 10 August 2026, the exhibiting company will forfeit all payments made to the IAPRD under this agreement, and the company will be held liable for the full amount of the cost of the exhibit space.

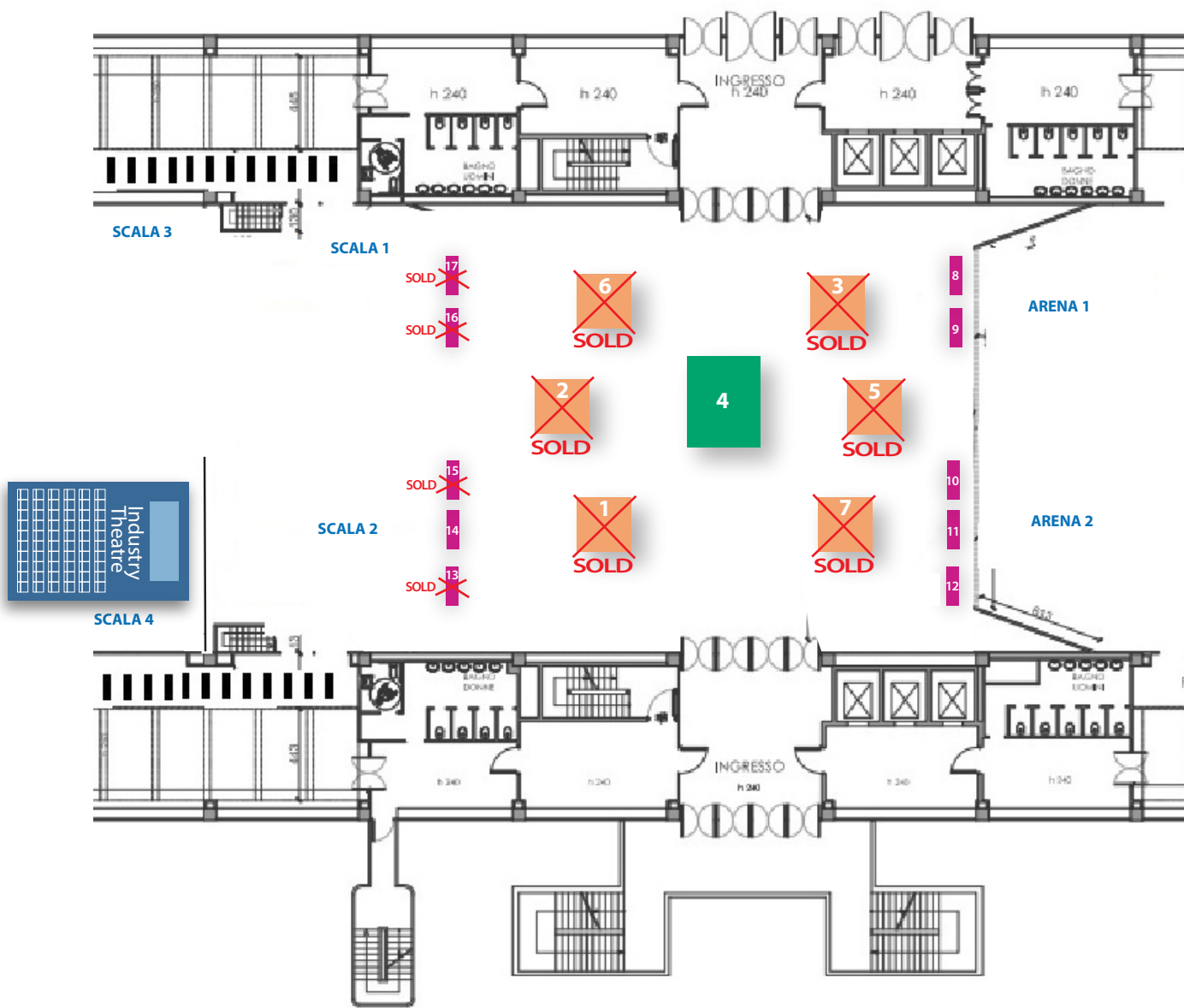
